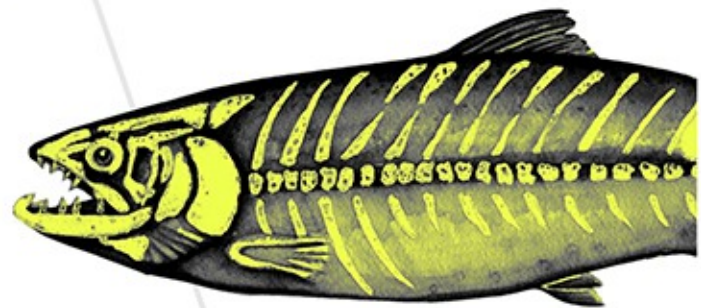
This severe danger to our health has been confirmed by Northern Health Doctors. As well, our lives and environment will be adversely affected by:
